The Northland Church of Christ in Columbus, Ohio is looking for a pulpit minister. Northland is a multi-culture, local mission minded, 120+ member congregation located in an urban area of northeast Columbus. Active outreach ministries include: Food Pantry, Clothing Closet, Child Care, Women's Prison Ministry, and Senior Citizens' Home. The Northland Church also includes an 80+ Ghana and 25+ Spanish member congregations that meet independently.

Most importantly, Northland is looking for a man who loves God and is devoted to knowing and sharing His word. It would be expected that he has good personal study habits and regular prayer. He should be a man who devotes himself to others with an ultimate focus of helping them to know and trust God. His primary purpose would be to help expand the kingdom and help the church here at Northland grow.

Accountability:

- The minister will be expected to work with the elders, deacons, youth coordinator, and the rest of the church staff to determine the best way to address the needs of the members.
- The minister will be expected to meet regularly with the elders individually and as a group to mentor and develop each other to bring glory to God.

- Involved in prayer groups and small groups

- Involved in regular visitation (i.e., hospitalized, shut-ins, etc.)
